- 1. Duration of the paper will be **Two Hours (11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.)**
- 2. Each question will be of one mark.
- 3 There will be no negative marking.
- 4. The candidate is to select one correct answer and mark it on OMR Sheet only with Black/Blue ink Ball/Gel pen.

## **Instructions for filling the OMR Sheet**

- 1. The candidate must fill his/her Roll Number in words and figures at specified places. For this purpose, ten circles marked as 0,1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8 and 9 have been provided below every digit.
- 2. In the response sheet, each question has four circles, which have been designated as A, B, C and D out of which one circle should be shaded.
- 3. Each question will consist of four alternative choices marked as A, B, C and D. Out of these one is correct. For every question, which the candidate wants to attempt, corresponding circle out of A, B, C or D should be shaded on the OMR sheet.
- 4. Marking more than one answer for a question will be treated as wrong answer and no marks will be awarded for it.
- 5. Half filled circles will be treated as wrong answer.
- 6. Shade the circles in such way that no white space is left. Partially shaded circles may not be resolved properly, which may result in wrong answer.
- 7. Use of a Pencil for shading the circles is not allowed.
- 8. Writing anything on the response sheet except at the specified places may lead to cancellation of result.
- 9. Use of rubber, blade or fluid to alter the responses is strictly prohibited.
