1. Duration of the paper will be **Two Hours (11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.)**
2. Each question will be of one mark.
3. There will be no negative marking.
4. The candidate is to select one correct answer and mark it on OMR Sheet only with Black/Blue ink Ball/Gel pen.

Instructions for filling the OMR Sheet

1. The candidate must fill his/her Roll Number in words and figures at specified places. For this purpose, ten circles marked as 0,1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8 and 9 have been provided below every digit.
2. In the response sheet, each question has four circles, which have been designated as A, B, C and D out of which one circle should be shaded.
3. Each question will consist of four alternative choices marked as A, B, C and D. Out of these one is correct. For every question, which the candidate wants to attempt, corresponding circle out of A, B, C or D should be shaded on the OMR sheet.
4. Marking more than one answer for a question will be treated as wrong answer and no marks will be awarded for it.
5. Half filled circles will be treated as wrong answer.
6. Shade the circles in such way that no white space is left. Partially shaded circles may not be resolved properly, which may result in wrong answer.
7. Use of a Pencil for shading the circles is not allowed.
8. Writing anything on the response sheet except at the specified places may lead to cancellation of result.
9. Use of rubber, blade or fluid to alter the responses is strictly prohibited.
