

## IMPORTANT GUIDELINES FOR CANDIDATES

- Candidates seeking admission shall be required to fill the online Application Form by the stipulated date.
- Students seeking admission to MBA Two-Year Regular Course through Entrance Test and Group Discussion conducted by Punjabi University, Patiala need to upload their scanned Photograph & Signature during online submission of Application Form.
- Eligibility of the candidate will not be determined at the time of Entrance Test and Group Discussion. It will be determined at the time of Counseling. Therefore, a candidate may appear in Entrance Test and Group Discussion at his/ her own risk. The candidates are strictly advised to check their eligibility criteria mentioned in Online Prospectus.
- Candidates will be able to print the Admit Card online after a particular date (notified at website [www.pupadmissions.ac.in](http://www.pupadmissions.ac.in)). In case of any problem, you can collect Admit Card from the Centralized Admission Cell at Punjabi University, Patiala one day before the date of Entrance Test (For updates regularly visit at [www.pupadmissions.ac.in](http://www.pupadmissions.ac.in))
- **Application Processing-cum-Entrance Test Fee/Counseling Fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.**
- If a candidate fails to appear in the Entrance Test/Group Discussion/Counseling for any reason, whatsoever, or if his/her application is rejected on any ground including his/her ineligibility to appear in the Entrance Test/Group Discussion/ Counseling or late receipt of application, the fee shall not be refunded.
- **The final result of the Entrance Test and Group Discussion will be made available at the website [www.pupadmissions.ac.in](http://www.pupadmissions.ac.in)**
- The University reserves the right not to give admission to any candidate without assigning any reason.
- Candidate with a gap of one year or more will have to furnish an undertaking to the satisfaction of the Admission Committee, that he/she was not involved in any Unfair Means Case or Police Case during the gap period.
